The Priory Theatre is delighted to host the Central Region LTG one-day Conference on Saturday 26th October 2024. For delegates, The Priory will present [*The Addams Family, a New Musical Comedy*](#).

The Fee includes Saturday lunch, teas, coffee and workshops and the Friday, or Saturday, evening performance of *The Addams Family*. Should a delegate not wish to see the evening performance, the delegate fee will be £11. Delegates will pay for their evening meal at a venue of their choice before the performance on Saturday evening.

There will be small group tours of the Theatre and Wardrobe, which is situated in a building two minutes' walk from the theatre. The Theatre is fully accessible with a ramp and lift to the auditorium, but there is only ground floor access to the wardrobe and rehearsal room above.
